- 2) Approval of Agenda and June 12, 2025 AGM Meeting Minutes

#### 3) Financials and Fundraising Discussion

Reviewed and discussed all the cost break downs from the agenda. Overall accounts all look healthy. The overall 2024/25 spend will be within the approved request for funds and accruals will be held until all bills from the 2024-25 school year are cleared.

# 4) 2024/25 Priority List Accruals Update

## 5) 2025/26 Priority List Funding Update from Helen

- c) School Dream List Discussion (school enhancing based on feedback from teachers) - Helen listed some of the previously discussed dream list items; whisper phones, tables by the playground, upkeep of the outdoor school mural, 3D printer for the school, more blue mats, laminator table, back door key FOBs, music room xylophone stands.

One Kindergarten space available.

The grade 1-6 program has increased spaces available from 45 children last school year to 50 children this year. As of September 25, 2025 the grade 1-6 program is full and all students that were on the waitlist from June 2025 have all been offered spots. Exciting to offer all families needing care this year the option to enter the program!
